



CPSC ADULT INDOOR SOCCER LEAGUE RULES and REGULATIONS

Call-up Players

- ⚽ Any player who receives two cautions or one dismissal across the course of the session will not be eligible to participate as a call-up for the remainder of the session.
- ⚽ This is done in an attempt to discourage behaviour that warrants discipline. Playing as a call-up is a privilege. If players decide they want to behave in a dangerous or reckless manner, they will lose this privilege. It was chosen that two cautions or one dismissal be the standard for this new regulation as the repeat of a caution, or the severity of the offence leading to a dismissal, is considered to be an established pattern of negative behaviour.

Discipline

- ⚽ Any player who is suspended for a game that, due to any circumstance, does not get played, will be given a new date for their suspension to be served – if the game is not played, the suspension is not served.
- ⚽ At the end of each session, any cautions (yellow cards) players have received will be wiped clean. There is no accumulation of cautions across sessions. However, dismissals (red cards), being much more serious offences, can be accumulated from both sessions.

Kick-off

- ⚽ A goal may be scored directly from a kick-off.
